Country Fire Authority Act 1958.

SUMMER PERIOD IN RESPECT OF SPECIFIED PARTS
OF THE COUNTRY AREA OF VICTORIA.

WHEREAS by section 4 of the *Country Fire Authority Act 1958* it is enacted that the Chief Secretary of Victoria, after consultation with the Minister of Forests, may from time to time by declaration published in the *Government Gazette* declare any period to be the summer period in respect of the country area of Victoria, or any specified part or parts thereof and, without affecting the generality of the foregoing, may declare different periods to be the summer period in respect of different parts of the said country area:

And whereas the Chief Secretary and the Minister of Forests have consulted accordingly:

Now therefore I, the Chief Secretary of Victoria, do hereby declare the period commencing at midnight on the 7th November, 1969, and ending at midnight on the 30th April, 1970, to be the summer period in respect of the parts of the country area of Victoria specified in the Schedule hereto being portions of the Eighteenth Fire Control Region.

SCHEDULE (No. 1).

Those portions of the Eighteenth Fire Control Region comprised by the Municipal Districts of the City of Mildura, the Shire of Mildura with the exception of those portions which lie within the Parishes of Mildura and Merbein and the Shire of Walpeup.
