## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by Section 1 (3) of the Land Tax Act 1968
(No. 7773) it is provided that the said Act shall come into operation on a day or the respective days fixed by proclamation or successive proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette:

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State do by this my Proclamation fix Tuesday the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, as the day on which paragraphs (a) and (b) of Section 6 of the Land Tax Act 1968 No. 7773 shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this first day of July, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, and in the eighteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
