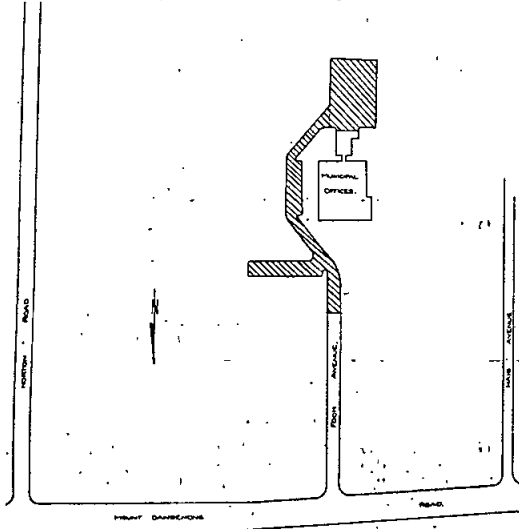

IN pursuance with the powers conferred by the *Local Government Acts* and *Uniform Building Regulations 1969* and of any and every other power it thereunto enabling, the President, Councillors and Ratepayers of the Shire of Kerang order as follows:—

By-Law Repealed.

1. By-Law No. 22 of the Shire of Kerang is hereby repealed.

Area Controlled by By-Law.

2. This By-Law shall operate and have effect throughout the Municipality and no person shall in such area construct any building without conforming with the requirements of the *Uniform Building Regulations 1969*.

Site Requirements.

3. The minimum area, depth, and width of frontage specified in Column 3 of Table 804 of the *Uniform Building Regulations 1969* are hereby adopted as the minimum area, depth and width of frontage of land on which buildings of Class I. or Class II. Occupancy shall be constructed throughout the area.

Distance from Frontage.

4. The minimum distance of the outer walls of any building of Class I. or II. Occupancy from frontage is hereby specified to be twenty feet (20 ft.)

Rear Access.

5. The requirements of Clause 813 of the Uniform Building Regulations 1969 are dispensed with in the case of a building on any land forming part of a subdivision approved by the Council and lodged in the Office of Titles prior to date of commencement of these Regulations.

Fowl Houses Kennels, Etc.

6. Fowlhouses, kennels, conservatories, greenhouses, aviaries and similar structures appurtenant to Buildings of Class I, II and IV. Occupancy shall be constructed in conformity with the following requirements:—

- (a) Such structures not to exceed 100 square feet in superficial area and eight feet in height.
- (b) Such structures to be distant not less than 75 feet from the frontage, 10 feet from any other street or road and, 5 feet from the boundary of any adjoining allotment of land.
- (c) The whole of such structure to be covered and roofed with material approved of by the surveyor.
- (d) Such structures to be distant not less than 40 feet from any dwelling-house, whether on the same land or on adjoining land.
