BOARD OF INQUIRY INTO THE CONDUCT OF MR. J.
MEDENIEKS AT JANEFIELD TRAINING CENTRE.

WHEREAS allegations have been made by various members of the staff at Janefield Training Centre against Julijs Medenieks:

And whereas it is deemed expedient that a Board be appointed to inquire and report as to whether, upon the whole of the evidence, disciplinary action should be taken against Julijs Medenieks pursuant to the provisions of the *Mental Health Act 1959* arising out of his treatment of and conduct towards his subordinates at Janefield Training Centre:

Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth by this Order constitute and appoint William Norman Thompson, Stipendiary Magistrate, to be a Board for the purpose of inquiring and reporting as aforesaid, with full power and authority to call before him any person whose evidence in his judgment is material to the subject matter of the inquiry to be made by the Board and to inquire of and concerning the premises by all lawful means whatsoever:

And it is hereby directed that the said William Norman Thompson shall, with as little delay as possible, report under his hand his opinion resulting from this inquiry:

Whereof the said, William Norman Thompson and all other persons whom it may concern are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

And the Honorable Sir Arthur Gordon Rylah, Her Majesty's Chief Secretary for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
