PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Lieutenant-General the Honorable Sir Edmund Francis Herring, K.C.M.G., K.B.E., D.S.O., M.C., E.D., Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia &c., &c., &c.

HEREAS by a Commission under the Royal Sign Manual and Signet, bearing date the Thirtieth day of July, One thousand nine hundred and forty-five, His Majesty King George VI. was graciously pleased to appoint me to be thousand nine hundred and forty-five, His Majesty King George VI. was graciously pleased to appoint me to be the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, with all the powers, rights, privileges, and advantages to the said Office belonging or appertaining; and further, in case of the death, incapacity, or removal of the Governor of the said State, or of his assuming the administration of the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia, to authorize and require me to administer the Government of the said State, with all and singular the powers and authorities contained in certain Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, bearing date at Westminster the Twenty-ninth day of October, One thousand nine hundred, constituting and Ireland, bearing date at Westminster the Thirtieth day of April, One thousand nine hundred and thirteen making further provision for the administration of the Thirtieth day of April, One thousand nine hundred and thirteen making further provision for the administration of the Government of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in certain events. And whereas the said Governor having assumed the administration of the Governor of the said State, do hereby proclaim that all the powers and authorities by Francis Herring, the Lieutenant-Governor of the said State of Victoria and its Dependencies and by virtue of the said State now residing therein, to be by me exercised and enjoyed in accordance with the terms of the said Commission.

Given under my Hand the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twelfth day of October, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy-one and in the twentieth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
