## REWARD.

Notice is hereby given that a reward or rewards will be paid by the Government of Victoria in accordance with the conditions set out hereunder for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of any person or persons responsible for the death of Desmond St. Bernard Costello on the 12th December, 1971.

## CONDITIONS.

- 1. The person or persons giving information leading to the apprehension and conviction of a person or persons guilty of the above-mentioned crime will receive such amount or amounts not exceeding \$2,000 as shall be determined by the Chief Commissioner of Police.
- 2. The person or persons entitled to any reward and the amount or amounts payable to such person or persons shall be determined by the Chief Commissioner of Police.
