MARINE ACT 1972, No. 8293.

DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the twenty-first year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II entitled the *Marine Act 1972*, No. 8293, it is amongst other things enacted that the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Thursday the first day of June One thousand nine hundred and seventy-two as the day on which all Sections other than Section 9 of the said *Marine Act 1972*, No. 8293, shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this thirtieth day of May, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy-two and in the twenty-first year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
