DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria
and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia,
&c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria
entitled the *Victorian Development Corporation Act 1973*,
No. 8428, it is stated that the said Act will come into
operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the
Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in
the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice
of the Executive Council of the said State do by this my
Proclamation fix Tuesday the eighth day of May, One
thousand nine hundred and seventy three as the day on
which the provisions of the *Victorian Development Corporation Act 1973*, No. 8428, shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of
Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this eighth day
of May, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine
hundred and seventy-three, and in the twenty-
second year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen
Elizabeth II.
