VARIATION OF ORDER FIXING DATES FOR ELECTION
OF SENATORS FOR VICTORIA.

His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria,
by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof,
and in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Senate
Elections Act 1958*, doth by this Order:—

1. Revoke the Order dated the 5th April, 1974, and
published in the *Victoria Government Gazette* of the
5th April, 1974, fixing the dates for the purpose of the
election of Senators for Victoria of the Parliament of the
Commonwealth.

2. Fix the following dates for the purpose of the
election of Senators for Victoria of the Parliament of the
Commonwealth, viz.:—

The issue of the writ—20th April, 1974.

The nomination of the candidates—29th April, 1974.

The polling—18th May, 1974.

The return of the writ—on or before 29th June, 1974.

And doth appoint the Office of the Australian Electoral
Officer for Victoria at Australian Government Centre,
corner Spring and La Trobe Streets, Melbourne, to be the
place for the nomination of candidates.

And the Honorable John Frederick Rossiter, Her
Majesty's Chief Secretary for the State of Victoria, shall
give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
