DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the twenty-third year of the reign of Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia, entitled the *Motor Car (Further Amendment) Act 1974, No. 8561*, it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day or respective dates to be fixed by proclamation or successive proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*:

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State do by this my proclamation:—

- (1) fix Monday the tenth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-four as the day on which Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 13, 14 and 15 of the said Act shall come into operation; and
- (2) fix Monday the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-four as the day on which Sections 10, 11 and 12 of the said Act shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, this sixth day of June, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy-four, and in the twenty-third year of the reign of Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
