*Country Fire Authority Act 1958.*

FIRE DANGER PERIOD IN RESPECT OF SPECIFIED  
PARTS OF THE COUNTRY AREA OF VICTORIA.

Whereas by section 4 of the *Country Fire Authority Act 1958*, it is enacted that the Chief Secretary of Victoria, after consultation with the Minister of Forests, may from time to time by declaration published in the *Government Gazette* declare any period to be the fire danger period in respect of the country area of Victoria, or any specified part or parts thereof and, without affecting the generality of the foregoing, may declare different periods to be the fire danger period in respect of different parts of the said country area:

And whereas the Chief Secretary and the Minister of Forests have consulted accordingly:

Now therefore, I, the Chief Secretary of Victoria, do hereby declare the period commencing at midnight on the 24th December, 1975 and ending at midnight on the 30th April, 1976, to be the fire danger period in respect of the parts of the country area of Victoria situated within the municipal districts or parts of municipal districts, being part of the Sixteenth Fire Control Region specified in the Schedule hereunder:—

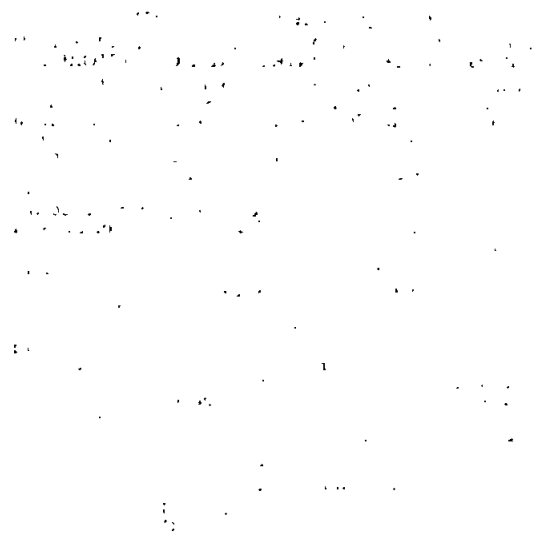

LAND TAX ACT 1975 No. 8770.

### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by sub-section (3) of section 1 of the Land Tax Act No. 8770 it is provided that section 2 shall come into operation on the 1st day of January 1976 and the other provisions of the Act shall come into operation on the day or the respective days to be fixed by proclamation of successive proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Thursday, the 1st day of January 1976, as the day on which the other provisions of the said Act shall come into operation.

### PROCLAMATION

upon receipt of certification by the clerk of the municipality concerned (Shire of Warragul) that the land is or has been used for recreational purposes (a hall), do hereby declare all that piece of land being part of Crown allotment 69 in the Parish of Warragul and more particularly described in Certificate of Title Volume 5439 Folio 650, to be land to which the said Section 22c (2) applies.—(C.101506.)

### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the twenty-fourth year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia, entitled the *Dental Technicians (Amendment) Act 1975* (No. 8808) it is amongst other things enacted that the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*:

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my proclamation fix Wednesday the thirty-first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-five, as the day on which the whole of the said *Dental Technicians (Amendment) Act 1975* (No. 8808) shall come into operation.
