PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do hereby declare that I have this day assented, in Her Majesty's name, to the Bills passed by the Parliament of the said State, the titles whereof are hereunder set forth, together with the short titles, that is to say: is to say:-

- No. 8690. "An Act to make further Provision with respect to Trotting, to amend the 'Racing Act 1958' and for other purposes." (Racing Act 1975.)
 No. 8691. "An Act to amend the 'Teaching Service Act 1958' to permit the Appointment of Assistant Professional Appointees, and for other purposes." (Teaching Service (Assistant Professional Appointees) Act 1975.)
