POLICE REGULATION (PENSIONS) ACT 1975, No. 8722.

DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the twenty-fourth year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia, entitled the *Police Regulation (Pensions) Act 1975, No. 8722*, it is amongst other things enacted that the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*:

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Tuesday, the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-five as the day on which the whole of the said *Police Regulation (Pensions) Act 1975, No. 8722*, shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this first day of July, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy-five, and in the twenty-fourth year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
