FIRES WITHIN THE STATE OF VICTORIA.

REWARD

Notice is hereby given that a reward or rewards will be paid by the Government of Victoria, in accordance with the conditions set out hereunder, for information leading to the conviction of any person or persons guilty of an act of illegally lighting a property, bush, scrub or grass fire, or of aiding and abetting such act, within the State of Victoria on days of total fire ban.

Conditions.

1. The person or persons giving information leading to the conviction of any person in connexion with the act of lighting such fires, or aiding and abetting such act, will receive an amount or amounts not exceeding \$10,000.

2. The persons entitled to any reward and the amount payable to such persons, shall be determined by the Chief Commissioner of Police.

3. The offer of this reward will remain open until 30th June, 1975.

Information may be given at any time by telephoning or visiting the Officer in Charge of any Police Station. Applications for payment of a reward should be submitted to the Chief Commissioner of Police, Box 2763Y, G.P.O., Melbourne, 3001.
