LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1958, SECTION 45B.

Take notice that the Minister of Labour and Industry, pursuant to section 45B of the *Labour and Industry Act 1958*, (as amended) has referred to the Industrial Appeals Court for determination by it the matter of an application to each of the Wages Boards mentioned in Part I. of the Schedule hereunder to amend its Determination by inserting the following (or similar) provisions:

"When any of the days mentioned in sub-clause (a) of this clause falls on a Saturday or a Sunday the holiday shall be observed on the next succeeding Monday and when Boxing Day falls on a Sunday or a Monday the holiday shall be observed on the next succeeding Tuesday. In each case the substituted day shall be a holiday without deduction of pay and the day for which it is substituted will be a holiday."

and an application to each of the Wages Boards mentioned in Part II. of the Schedule hereunder to amend its Determination by providing for the substitution of Monday, 26th April, 1976, for Anzac Day, Sunday 25th April, 1976.

PART I.
