VICTORIAN INLAND MEAT AUTHORITY ACT 1974

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas section 5 of the *Victorian Inland Meat Authority Act 1974* provides that on a day fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette* being a day after the day upon which the Treasurer has certified that the affairs of the Victorian Inland Meat Authority have been wound up, the said Authority shall be abolished and the Acts mentioned in the Schedule to the aforesaid Act, to the extent there expressed to be repealed, and the aforesaid Act, shall be repealed:

And whereas the Treasurer has certified that the affairs of the Authority have been wound up:

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation fix Thursday, the 1st December, 1977, as the day on which the Victorian Inland Meat Authority shall be abolished and the Acts mentioned in the Schedule to the aforesaid Act, to the extent there expressed to be repealed, and the aforesaid Act, shall be repealed.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twentieth day of November, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy-seven, and in the twenty-sixth year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
