MURDER

REWARD.

Notice is hereby given that a reward of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) will be paid, in accordance with the conditions set out hereunder, for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the deaths of Suzanne Joy Armstrong and Susan Jan Bartlett on or about 10th January, 1977.

The bodies of Suzanne Joy Armstrong and Susan Jan Bartlett were found in their residence at 147 Easey Street, Collingwood, on the 13th January, 1977. The last known sighting of the deceased prior to their deaths was at about 8.45 p.m. on the 10th January, 1977, when they were visited by one of the deceased's brothers.

CONDITIONS.

1. The person or persons giving information leading to the apprehension and conviction of a person or persons guilty of the above-mentioned crime will receive such amount or amounts not exceeding \$20,000 as shall be determined by the Chief Commissioner of Police.

2. The person or persons entitled to any reward and the amount or amounts payable to such person or persons shall be determined by the Chief Commissioner of Police.

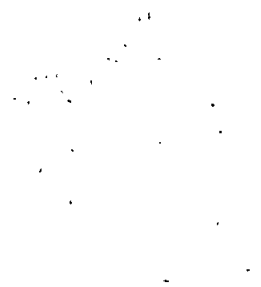
