(d) The charge for water supplied outside the Waterworks Trust District by measure is hereby fixed at 8 cents per Kilolitre, and the minimum quantity of water to be charged for in cases where water is supplied is hereby fixed at 334 Kilolitres.

(e) The charge for water supplied by measure shall be payable on demand at the Office of the Trust.

3. Such Officers as the Trust from time to time may appoint for the purpose are hereby authorised to demand, receive and recover the said charges.

(a) the maximum quantity of water to be supplied in any meter year without charge is hereby fixed at a quantity which if charged at 24.4 cents per kilolitre for any meter year would give an amount equal to the amount of the rate payable in respect of the land or tenement for the financial year in which the said meter year ended.

(b) For all water supplied in any meter year in excess of the maximum quantity referred to in paragraph (a) of this clause the charge is hereby fixed at 24.4 cents per kilolitre for any meter year.

5. Subject as is hereinafter provided the charge for water supplied by measure to any property not rated by the Trust is hereby fixed at 24.4 cents per kilolitre.

6. The minimum charge for water supplied by measure to any property not rated by the Trust is hereby fixed at Fifty-four dollars.

7. The aforesaid charges shall be payable within seven days of demand upon the owner or occupier at the office of the Trust, Noorinbee, or the Shire Office, Orbost.

8. The provisions of clause 6 of this By-law shall not apply to any land tenement or property supplied with water by the Trust under a special agreement pursuant to Section 215 of the *Water Act 1958*.


