CALL OF THE WHOLE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SOUTH BARWON TO ATTEND A SPECIAL
MEETING OF SUCH COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the provisions of sub-section 2 of section 187 of the *Local Government Act 1958*, I, Alan John Hunt, the Minister of the Crown administering the said Act, do hereby make a call of the whole Council of the City of South Barwon to attend a Special Meeting of such Council to be held in the Council Chambers, Thomson Street, Belmont, on Friday, 18th February, 1977, at 8.00 o'clock p.m.

The object of the meeting is to transact the following business in open Council:—

1. To hear the Minister in relation to the position of the Town Clerk and the problems of the Council.
2. To specify and particularise the reasons for the suspension of the Town Clerk, in place of the generalised allegations conveyed as purported reasons at the time of the suspension.
3. To debate and resolve upon, or otherwise abandon, each item and each particular which may be proposed as a reason, or as supporting a reason, for the suspension of the Town Clerk.
4. To consider and resolve upon the ways and means in and by which the council and its staff may in future most effectively serve the interests of the ratepayers and citizens of the City.
