EDUCATION (AMENDMENT) ACT 1978, No. 9101

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of the Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the twenty-seventh year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II., intituled the *Education (Amendment) Act 1978, No. 9101*, it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my proclamation fix Tuesday, the twenty-first day of November, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-eight as the day upon which all the provisions of the *Education (Amendment) Act 1978, No. 9101* shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty-first day of November, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy-eight, and in the twenty-seventh year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
