Direction No. 3

*Fuel Emergency Act 1977*  
MOTOR CYCLES, MOPEDS, &c.  
DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 4

To the owner or operator of a service station situated within the State of Victoria.

I, James Charles Murray Balfour, Minister for Minerals and Energy, pursuant to Section 4 of the *Fuel Emergency Act 1977*, in relation to the directions issued on 12 March 1980, under the said Section 4, hereby give the following further direction, namely:

In paragraph (a) of Schedule 1 of Direction No. 1 or Direction No. 2 as the case may be the expression "less than the value of \$2.00" shall not apply in regard to the sale or supply of motor spirit to motor cycles, mopeds, and other like two-wheeled vehicles.

This direction operates as and from 13 March 1980 and ends on 16 March 1980.

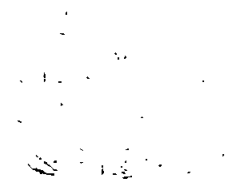
