DATE OF OPERATION

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the Twenty-ninth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II., entitled the *Victorian Film Corporation (Amendment) Act 1980*, No. 9376, it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.

Now thereafter I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix the First day of July, One thousand nine hundred and eighty, as the day on which Section 6 of the said *Victorian Film Corporation (Amendment) Act 1980*, No. 9376 shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this first day of July, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty, and in the twenty-ninth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
