CESSATION OF POWERS AND DUTIES OF COMMISSIONER—CITY OF KEILOR

Whereas in pursuance of the provisions of Division 2
of Part I. of the *Local Government Act 1958*—

- (a) by an Order in Council published in the *Government Gazette* of 15 July 1975 Kevin Miles Holland was appointed Commissioner of the City of Keilor;
- (b) by an Order in Council published in the *Government Gazette* of 30 April 1980, 9 August 1980 was appointed a day for holding an election of councillors for the said city; and
- (c) at the election of councillors held on 9 August 1980 the whole number of councillors assigned to the municipality were returned—

Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, hereby gives notice that a sufficient number of councillors to form a quorum of the Council of the City of Keilor have been elected and that on the day of publication of this Order in the *Government Gazette* all the powers and duties of the said Kevin Miles Holland as Commissioner of the City of Keilor shall cease.

And the Honorable Digby Glen Crozier, Her Majesty's Minister for Local Government for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
