DATE OF OPERATION

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the thirtieth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, entitled the *Exhibition (Amendment) Act 1981*, No. 9597, it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix the Twenty-second day of December, One thousand nine hundred and eighty-one, as the day on which the provisions of the *Exhibition (Amendment) Act 1981* shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty-second day of December, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty-one, and in the thirtieth year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth II, Queen of Australia.

Patterson River Dredging Buoy Established

Date—On or about 22 December 1981.

Reference Position—Patterson River Entrance, North Groyne light (Lat. 38 deg. 04.5 min. S., Long. 145 deg. 07.1 min. E. approximately).

Intermittent dredging operations are in progress off the mouth of the Patterson River.

A small unlit yellow spar buoy will be placed in a position bearing 225 deg. distant 225 m. from the reference position. The buoy may be moved from time to time or removed from the area without further notice.

Mariners are warned to keep clear of the dredging operations and watch for signals displayed from the dredging vessel.
