## REWARD

**\$25 000**

The co-operation of the general public is sought in obtaining information which will assist in the apprehension and arrest of Debra Mary Boundy who failed to appear at the Melbourne County Court on 2 February 1981, in connection with charges of perjury.

Miss Boundy, aged 20 years, is described as being 165 cm. (5' 5") tall, of slim build, with fair complexion, fair hair and blue eyes. She has a 10 cm. (4") scar on the right forearm and a 5 cm. (2") scar on the right shoulder.

A reward of up to twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25 000) will be paid at the discretion of the Chief Commissioner of Police by the Government of Victoria for information leading to the apprehension and arrest of Debra Mary Boundy.

Any information, which will be treated as confidential, may be given at any time of the day or night to the Officer in Charge, Criminal Investigation Branch, Russell Street, Melbourne (telephone 667 1911) or to the Officer in Charge of any Police Station.
