REWARD

The co-operation of the general public is sought with a view to establishing the identity of the person or persons responsible for the death of Raymond Patrick Bennett who was shot dead at the Melbourne Magistrates' Court on 12 November 1979.

A reward of fifty thousand dollars (\$50 000) will be paid, at the discretion of the Chief Commissioner of Police, by the Government of Victoria for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for this crime.
