#### REWARD

The co-operation of the general public is sought with a view to establishing the identity of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Father George Scerri, a Priest of the Maltese Mission situated at 9 Sydney Road, Brunswick.

A reward of fifty thousand dollars (\$50 000) will be paid at the discretion of the Chief Commissioner of Police by the Government of Victoria, for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for this crime.
