#### Submissions Invited on the Use of Public Land


Submissions are now invited from interested persons and bodies in regard to the use of public land within the area. These submissions will be considered by the Council when making recommendations as to the balanced use of the land.

And whereas Leonard Swinden has resigned as Vice-President of the Ambulance Service—Melbourne.


Now therefore, I, His Excellency the Governor in Council appoint John David Moir, a current member, as Vice-President of the Ambulance Service—Melbourne.


VESTING PLAN
