Whereas by the Local Government Act 1958, section 519 it is amongst other things enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council at any time and from time to time upon the request of the council of any municipality by notice in the Government Gazette to proclaim any land reserved used or by purchase or exchange acquired for a street road highway thoroughfare bridge square court alley or right-of-way or any street road lane or passage made or laid out or proposed to be made or laid out on any land of which a plan of subdivision delineating that street road lane or passage has been sealed with the seal of the municipality under subdivision (3) of Division 9 of Part XIX of the Local Government Act 1958 or a corresponding previous enactment to be a public highway and that such land shall thereupon and thenceforth from the date of such proclamation become and be absolutely dedicated to the public as a public highway within the meaning of any law then or thereafter in force.

And whereas the Council of the United Shire of Beech-

And whereas the Council of the United Shire of Beechworth has requested that the land hereinafter mentioned, used for a street, be so declared to be a public highway.

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this proclamation declare that the road, shown by hatching on the plan hereunder shall be a public highway within the meaning of the said Act.

MAGISTRATES (SUMMARY PROCEEDINGS) ACT 1975 No. 9731

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas:

(I.) By the Magistrates (Summary Proceedings) Act 1975 section 88 it is provided, amongst other things, that the Governor in Council may by proclamation published in the Government Gazette declare as many Magistrates' Courts as he thinks necessary within the "metropolitan area" within the meaning of the Town and Country Planning Act 1961 to be and to be known as "traffic courts" for the hearing or determination of matters brought by the alternative procedure by members of the Police Force in respect of offences referred to in Schedule Two of the Act.

(II.) A proclamation made under the said section 8 may, inter alia, proclaim any Magistrates' Court to be a traffic court for the hearing or determination of such matters in addition to the usual business of the Magistrates' Court and revoke or vary any proclamation made under any of the provisions of that section in force before the commencement of the Magistrates (Summary Proceedings) (Amendment) Act 1981.

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof do by this my Proclamation—

 (1) vary the Proclamation made by the Governor in Council and published in the Government Gazette of 27 October 1971, which, amongst other things, set aside absolutely the Magistrates' Courts at Kew and Flemington for the hearing or determination from 1 January 1972, of matters brought by the alternative procedure as aforesaid, and proclaimed the Magistrates' Courts at Kew and Flemington for the hearing or determination of matters which may be dealt with by the alternative procedure to be the appropriate courts for the hearing of matters arising within the respective municipal districts of the municipalities set opposite each of the said courts in the Schedule thereto, by revoking the setting aside absolutely of the Magistrates' Courts at Kew and Flemington for the hearing or determination from 1 July 1982, of matters brought by the alternative procedure as aforesaid; and cedure as aforesaid; and
- cedure as aforesaid; and

 (2) proclaim the Magistrates' Courts at Heidelberg and Williamstown to be traffic courts as from I July 1982, for the hearing or determination of matters brought by the alternative procedure by members of the police force in respect of offences referred to in the said Schedule Two of the Act which arise within the respective municipal districts of the municipalities set opposite each of the said courts in the Schedule hereto, in addition to the usual business of the Magistrates' Court

Films Act 1971

EXEMPTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 11 (2)

Whereas-

- 1. Section 11 (2) of the Films Act 1971 provides that the Governor in Council may in any particular case by direction in writing under his hand exempt any film from the operation of Part II. of the Act to the extent specified in the direction.
- 2. It is expedient that the films set out in the Schedule hereto be exempted from the provisions of Part II, of the said Act as would require:

the films to be examined and classified;

the advertising relating to the films to display classification or classification symbols;

applications for the registration of films to be accompanied by the prescribed fee.

Subject to the following conditions:

- (i) That the films be exhibited only at the Melbourne Film Festival during the period 3 June 1982 to 14 June 1982, both dates inclusive;
- (ii) That the films be exhibited not more than twice;
- (iii) That persons under the age of 18 years not be admitted to screenings of the films; and
- (iv) That the films be exported at the conclusion of the festival.

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Films Act 1971, do hereby exempt the films set out in the Schedule hereto from the provisions of Part II. of the Films Act 1971, subject to the conditions set out in item 2 above.
