\$50 000

The co-operation of the general public is sought with a view to establishing the identity of the person or persons responsible for the deaths of Abina Margaret Madill and Gary Charles Heywood, which occurred at Murchison East on or about 10 February 1966.

A reward of fifty thousand dollars (\$50 000) will be paid, at the discretion of the Chief Commissioner of Police, by the Government of Victoria, for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for these murders.

Any information, which will be treated as confidential, may be given at any time of the day or night to the Officer in Charge, Criminal Investigation Branch, Russell Street, Melbourne (telephone No. 667 1911) or to the Officer in Charge of any Police Station.
