ELECTION OF SENATORS FOR VICTORIA

His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, and in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Senate Elections Act 1958*, doth by this Order fix the following dates for the purpose of the election of Senators for Victoria of the Parliament of the Commonwealth, viz.:

The issue of the writ—4 February 1983.

The nomination of the candidates—19 February 1983.

The polling—5 March 1983.

The return of the writ—on or before 5 May 1983.

And doth appoint the Office of the Australian Electoral Officer for Victoria at Commonwealth Centre, corner Spring and La Trobe Streets, Melbourne, to be the place for the nomination of candidates.

And the Honourable John Hamilton Simpson, Her Majesty's Minister for Property and Services for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
