DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria  
and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia,  
&c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria  
passed in the thirty-second year of the reign of Her  
Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia,  
entitled the *Penalties and Sentences (Amendment) Act*  
1983, it is amongst other things enacted that the several  
provisions of the said Act except section 2 shall come into  
operation on a day or the respective days to be fixed by  
Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the  
*Government Gazette*.

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria,  
by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof,  
do by this my Proclamation fix Tuesday, 20 December 1983,  
as the day upon which the remaining provisions of the  
said Act, with the exception of section 8 thereof, shall  
come into operation.

## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the thirty-second year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia, entitled the *Country Fire Authority (Amendment) Act 1983*, it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on the day or respective days to be fixed by proclamation or successive proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.
