DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the thirty-first year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia, entitled the *Motor Car (General Amendment) Act 1982*, it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on the day or respective days to be fixed by Proclamation or successive Proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.

Now therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor as Deputy for the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Sunday, 9 January 1983, as the day on which sections 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 of the said *Motor Car (General Amendment) Act 1982*, shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this fifth day of January, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty-three, and in the thirty-first year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
