DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the thirty-second year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia, entitled the *Fire Authorities Act 1983* it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on the day or respective days to be fixed by Proclamation or successive Proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.

And whereas by Proclamation dated 28 June 1983, Wednesday, 29 June 1983, was fixed as the day on which section 13 of the said *Fire Authorities Act 1983, No. 9928*, was to come into operation.

Now therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor as Deputy for the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Wednesday, 20 July 1983, as the day on which sections 1 to 12 (inclusive) of the said *Fire Authorities Act 1983* shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria at Melbourne, this nineteenth day of July, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty-three, and in the thirty-second year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
