PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the thirty-third year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia, entitled the Fire Authorities Act 1984 it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on the day or respective days to be fixed by Proclamation or successive Proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette.

And whereas by Proclamation dated 13 November 1984 and published in the *Government Gazette* of 13 November 1984 sections 1-3, 5, 7-9, 11, 12 and 22-25 of the said Act were brought into operation on 13 November 1984.

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Saturday, 1 December 1984, as the day on which the remaining sections of the said Fire Authorities Act 1984, No. 10149, shall come into operation.

Now, therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Friday, 30 November 1984, as the day on which sections 10, 11, 12, 14, 16 and 17 (other than paragraph (a)) of the said State Electricity Commission (Coal Corporation of Victoria) Act 1984, No. 10145, shall come into operation, and Tuesday, I January 1985 as the day on which sections 13 and 15 of the said Act shall come into operation.
