Community Welfare Services Act 1970 HER MAJESTY'S PRISON, PENTRIDGE NOTICE

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas it is provided by section 114 of the Community Welfare Services Act 1970, that the Governor in Council may from time to time by notice in the *Government Gazette* appoint any buildings, erections, houses, enclosed places, and premises to be prisons.

And whereas, it is also provided by the said section 114 that the Governor in Council may from time to time revoke or vary any proclamation so made under that section or any corresponding previous enactment.

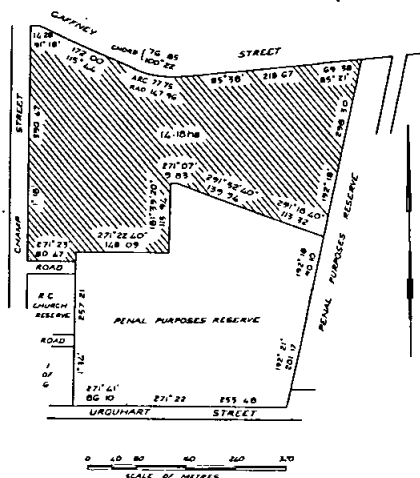
Now therefore, I, the Lieutenant-Governor as Deputy for His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this notice revoke, as from the 16 August 1984, the Proclamation mentioned in Schedule I hereunder, and in lieu thereof do hereby proclaim as from and inclusive of the aforesaid date, all buildings, erections, houses, enclosed places and premises within the area set out and described in Schedule II hereunder to be a prison under the title of "Her Majesty's Prison, Pentridge" and all buildings, erections, houses, enclosed places and premises within the area set out and described in Schedule III hereunder to be a prison under the title of "Her Majesty's Metropolitan Reception Prison".

SCHEDULE I

The Proclamation relating to Her Majesty's Prison, Pentridge issued on 26 April 1972 and published in the *Government Gazette* on 3 May 1972.

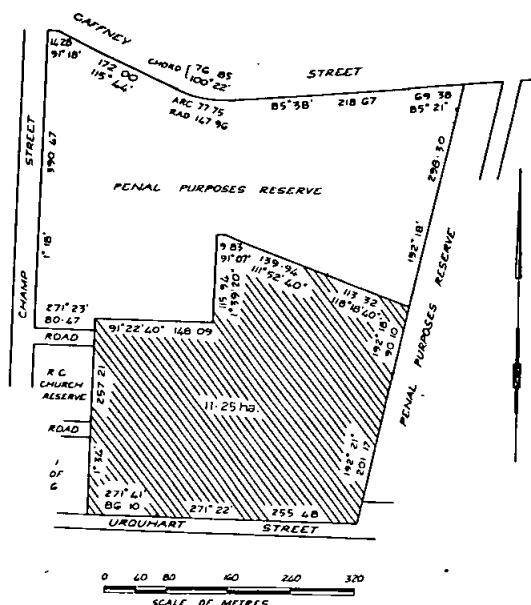
SCHEDULE II
