 - (a) The adequacy of current principles and procedures for the redistribution of general revenue funds from the Commonwealth to the States, including:
 - (i) the problems caused by the present system of revenue redistribution for the State Government and Parliament;
 - (ii) different mechanisms for revenue redistribution;
 - (iii) alternatives to revenue redistribution; and
 - (iv) adequacy of the intergovernmental decisionmaking process on revenue redistribution.
 - (b) The appropriate role of specific purpose payments in the Australian system of government.





The area proclaimed is the balance of the land not previously proclaimed in the catchment to Laanecoorie Reservoir. The catchment, hereby defined, includes the bed, the banks and the river environs of the Loddon River to the Dunolly offtake point about one kilometre downstream.

The use of land within this area is subject to specification by notice or by determination made by the Soil Conservation Authority, acting under the provisions of section 22 (2) and section 23 (1) (a) (b) and (c) of the Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act 1958, as amended.

The area described is indicated in Figure 1 (Plan No. S-1279A), hereunder the original of which is lodged at the office of the Soil Conservation Authority, 378 Cotham Road, Kew, 3101.
