Metropolitan Fire Brigades Act 1958
ALTERATIONS OF METROPOLITAN FIRE
DISTRICT

PROCLAMATION

By the Lieutenant-Governor as Deputy for His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas the councils of the municipal districts of the City of Croydon, the Shire of Lillydale and the Shire of Whittlesea have requested that portions of the

respective municipal districts be added to or excised from the Metropolitan Fire District;

And whereas a certificate has been received from the Metropolitan Fire Brigades Board that it is desirable so to do;

Now therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor as Deputy for His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, and in pursuance of the provisions of section 5 of the *Metropolitan Fire Brigades Act 1958*, do by this my proclamation declare that the portions of the municipal districts described hereunder shall from 1 July 1985, be added to and form part of the Metropolitan Fire District or excised therefrom as the case may be:

Areas Added to the Metropolitan Fire District

- (a) In the Shire of Whittlesea, commencing at the junction of the Merri Creek and Cooper Street, easterly by that street to the existing boundary of the Metropolitan Fire District and thence generally southerly, westerly and northerly by that boundary to the point of commencement;
- (b) In the Shire of Whittlesea, commencing at the junction of the Darebin Creek and Greenbrook Drive, generally north-easterly by Greenbrook Drive, to McDonalds Road, generally easterly by that road to Plenty Road, south-westerly and southerly by that road to the northern boundary of the property on which is situated the Melbourne and Metropolitan Board of Works Northern Region Complex, easterly by that boundary to the eastern boundary of the said property, southerly by that boundary to the northern boundary of the Janefield Colony, easterly by that boundary to the Plenty River, generally easterly and southerly by that river to the existing boundary of the Metropolitan Fire District and thence generally westerly, south-westerly, north-westerly and northerly by that boundary to the point of commencement.
- (c) In the Shire of Lillydale, commencing at the intersection of Pembroke Road and Cambridge Road, generally north-westerly, southerly, westerly, southerly and easterly by the existing boundary of the Metropolitan Fire District to Cambridge Road and thence north-westerly by that road to the point of commencement.
- (d) In the Shire of Lillydale, commencing at the intersection of Mt. Dandenong Road and Geoffrey Drive, southerly and westerly by Geoffrey Drive to Liverpool Road, southerly by that road to Orchard Street, westerly by that street and the continuation of that alignment to Colchester Road, northerly by that road to the existing boundary of the Metropolitan Fire District and thence generally easterly by that boundary to the point of commencement; and
- (e) In the City of Croydon, commencing at the intersection of Byron Road and Colchester Road, generally southerly by Colchester Road to Canterbury Road, generally south-westerly by that road to the existing boundary of the

Metropolitan Fire District and thence generally northerly and easterly by that boundary to the point of commencement.

Areas Excised from the Metropolitan Fire District

- (a) In the Shire of Whittlesea, commencing at the intersection of Miller Street and Cooper Street, easterly by Cooper Street to the Darebin Creek, thence generally northerly, westerly and southerly by the existing boundary of the Metropolitan Fire District to the point of commencement.
- (b) In the Shire of Lillydale, commencing at the intersection of Pembroke Road and Cambridge Road, generally north-westerly by Cambridge Road to Manchester Road, northerly by Manchester Road to the existing boundary of the Metropolitan Fire District and thence generally easterly, north-easterly, south-westerly, easterly and southerly to the point of commencement; and
- (c) In the Shire of Lillydale, commencing at the intersection of Durham Road and Balmoral Street, southerly by that street to Mt. Dandenong Road and thence generally south-easterly, northerly and westerly by the existing boundary of the Metropolitan Fire District to the point of commencement.

Estate Agents Act 1980

POLICY DIRECTIVE—SECTION 6B (3)

Eligibility to be Granted an Estate Agents Licence Section 14 (3)

In interpreting section 14 (3) the Board should continue to be guided by the decision in *Nakic v. Estate Agents Board*. Whilst the provision should not be read inflexibly, eligibility to be granted an Estate Agent's licence under the provision should only be established with respect to persons possessing qualifications and experience of a standard comparable to that of applicants able to establish eligibility under section 14 (1). In other words, where the applicant is deficient in any of the requirements of section 14 (1) (a), fitness to hold an Estate Agent's licence and eligibility to be granted such a licence, may nevertheless be established under section 14 (3) where the applicant has demonstrated to the Board that she or he possesses some quality, knowledge, ability, experience, acquirement, accomplishment or academic achievement by which the required standard is attained.

- (a) (i) all property plant equipment and works used or intended to be used by the Authority for the provision of sewerage services together with all interest rights benefits and advantages owned by vested in possessed by or accruing to the Authority in relation thereto;
- (ii) all rights and liabilities in land or easements owned by vested in or existing in favour of the Authority including any lands or easement in the process of being acquired as at 1 July 1986;
- (iii) all powers obligations and rights of the Authority in relation to the provision by it of sewerage services;
- (b) the ownership of all sewerage works hereinbefore described;
- (c) there shall be transferred the liabilities of the Authority to the Board by transferring as on and from 1 July 1986 the amounts shown in the books of the Authority at that date to the Board to the intent that such amounts shall be, as on and from that date, the responsibility of the Board;
- (d) all loans made or the balance of such loans available as at 1 July 1986 to the Authority be taken over by the Board on the terms and conditions applying to such loans immediately prior to that date;
- (e) all monies due and payable to the Authority as at 1 July 1986 in respect of the provision of sewerage services, shall by this Order, as on and from that date, be due and payable to the Board;
- (f) the officers and employees of the Authority and the City of Frankston Sewerage Authority Administrative officer as at 1 July 1986 shall cease to be officers and employees of the Authority and shall become officers and employees of the Board.

2. The Frankston Sewerage Authority, shall be abolished as on and from 1 July 1986.

3. The Frankston Sewerage District of the Authority, with such boundaries as apply as at 1 July 1986, shall be transferred to the jurisdiction of the Board on that date.

3. Exemption From Application For Building Approval Classes Xb and Xc

This By-law exempts persons from applying for Building Approval for Classes Xb and Xc Buildings which are to be constructed on farm land and used for farming purposes provided that such land is a parcel of land in excess of one (1) hectare in area and further in the case of a Class Xb building that the said building is situated not closer than nine (9) metres from a boundary, whether a road frontage or not.

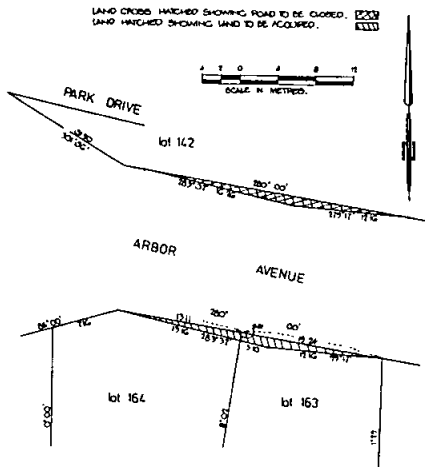
