Infertility (Medical Procedures) Act 1984 (No. 10163) COMMENCEMENT OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of the Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the thirty-third year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia, entitled the Infertility (Medical Procedures) Act 1984 it is, among other things, provided that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day, or on the respective days, to be fixed by proclamation, or successive proclamations, of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette:

Now, therefore, I the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State do by this my Proclamation fix Tuesday, 14 May 1985 as the day on which sections 1, 2 and 29 of the said *Infertility (Medical Procedures) Act* 1984, shall come into operation.
