### Films Act 1971

### **EXEMPTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 11 (2)**

Under the powers found in section 11 (2) of the Films Act 1971, the Governor in Council exempts the films set out in the Schedule below from the provisions of Part II of the Films Act 1971, subject to the following conditions:

- (i) That the films be exhibited only by the Australian Film Institute at a Festival at Melbourne, commencing on 5 December 1986, an event approved by the Attorney-General of the Commonwealth for the purposes of Part III of the Customs (Cinematograph Films) Regulations of the Commonwealth of Australia:
- (ii) That the films are screened not more than three times in the course of the approved event;
- (iii) In respect of imported films, that the films be exported or delivered to the holder of a permission in respect of the films, within the period of 6 weeks after the conclusion of the approved events;

- (iv) That the films are not screened other than before a subscription audience; and
- (v) That no person under the age of 18 years is admitted to screening of the films.

The remains are of historical, archaeological and recreational importance as those of a large and beautiful "clipper" ship built by Donald McKay of Boston, Massachusetts and owned by James Baines Black Ball Line.





  - 5. Where-
  - (a) before this Order takes effect a transaction happened in relation to an Old Body;

then—

(b) this Order does not affect the validity or continuity of the transaction, and the transaction shall continue and may be completed in relation to the New Body in the same way as it would have been continued and may have been completed in relation to the Old Body if this Order had not been made.

#### In this Order-

- "The Act" means the Administrative Arrangements Act 1983.
- "Body" means Minister, Administrative Unit or Officer.
- "Instrument" includes contract and agreement.
- "Old Body" and "New Body" mean respectively the Body specified in column 1 and Column 3 of each item in the Schedule.
- "Schedule" means the Schedule to this Order.
- "Transaction" includes-
  - (a) Agreement, bond, contract, deed or other consensual arrangement whatsoever;
  - (b) Action, appeal, arbitration, prosecution or other legal proceeding whatsoever;
  - (c) Assignment, charge, lease, mortgage, transfer or other dealing with property whatsoever;
  - (d) Loan, guarantee, indemnity or other dealing with money whatsoever;
  - (e) Approval, consent, delegation, direction, licence, Order, permit, requirement or other authority whatsoever;
  - (f) Notice; and
  - (g) Any other act, entitlement or liability in the law whatsoever.

Garbage Collection By-Law

A By-Law of the Shire of Waranga made under the provisions of the *Health Act* 1958 (as amended) with the approval of the Governor in Council and numbered 120 for the purpose of:

- (a) The provision use and control of receptacles for the deposit and collection of refuse and rubbish;
- (b) Preventing or regulating the deposit of refuse upon the streets and other lands and places under the control of the Council;
- (c) The removal replacement cleansing and disinfecting of receptacles for refuse; and the use of deodorants or disinfectants in such receptacles.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by the Health Act 1958, and in pursuance of all other powers it thereunto enabling the President, Councillors and Ratepayers of the Shire of Waranga order as follows:

#### Short Title

1. This By-Law may be cited as the Garbage Collection By-Law No. 120.

#### Operation

- 2. This By-Law shall have effect and operation the day following notice of its making is published in the Victoria Government Gazette.
- 3. This By-Law shall apply to and have operation in those parts of the municipal district of the Shire of Waranga specified in the schedule hereto.

#### By-Laws Repealed

- 4. (a) By-Law No. 99 of the Shire of Waranga is hereby repealed.
  - (b) By-Law No. 103 is amended as follows:
    - (i) in Clause I delete the words "Garbage Collection";
    - (ii) Clause 5 is hereby repealed.
  - (c) By-Law No. 113 is amended by repealing any reference to By-Law No. 99 in the Schedule to Clause 2.
- 5. In this By-Law unless inconsistent with the context or subject matter—
  - "Council" means the Council of the Shire of Waranga.
  - "Flat" means a portion of a building used or intended adapted or designed for use as a dwelling and includes any land surrounding or adjacent thereto within the same tenement.
  - "Occupier" means the occupier, owner, tenant, the person in charge or having the management or control of the premises.
  - "Premises" includes messuages, houses, flats, units, buildings, land and hereditaments of every tenure.
- "Receptacle" means a mobile cart constructed of high density plastic material having a maximum capacity of 240 litres, and constructed so as to prevent the absorption of any matter that may be deposited therein or the escape by leakage or otherwise of any part of the contents of such receptacle. It shall be provided with a strongly hinged lid of the same material as the body and be fitted with two wheels and two strong handles so as to enable easy manoeuverability.
- "Refuse" means all waste material (except nightsoil, sewage and manure) produced or accumulated in or about any house building or premises.
- "Unit" means a stratum which is shown as a unit on a plan of strata or Cluster Subdivision and includes a unit specified as an accessory unit.

- 6. The occupier of every premises shall keep and maintain the receptacle supplied by the Council at all times upon the premises into which all refuse shall be deposited with the least possible delay. Such receptacle shall remain the property of the Council and is not transferrable.
- A person shall not use for the collection of refuse as herein required any receptacle save as herein defined and as provided by the Council.
- 8. The occupier of every house flat unit or other premises shall provide a clearly defined area for the storage of receptacles.
- 9. The occupier shall cause such receptacles to be kept at all times in good order and condition, clean and disinfected and shall pay all repairs and/ or replacement costs in the event of damage or loss due to the act or default of the occupier.
- 10. A person shall not place refuse in a receptacle in such a manner that will prevent the lid of such receptacle from closing properly.
- 11. The occupier shall not cause or permit to be placed in a receptacle any live ashes, soil, paints, solvents or inflammable substances or any object which will cause damage to the receptacle or be dangerous.
- 12. The occupier shall keep the refuse in such receptacle in an inoffensive condition by the introduction of a sufficient quantity of deodorant or disinfectant or such other means.
- 13. The occupier shall not use or permit to be used the receptacle for any purpose other than for the collection of refuse therein.
- 14. Every receptacle shall have on the external surface painted or affixed thereto in clearly legible lettering the street number, and also in the case of flats or units the number of each flat or unit.
- 15. The occupier shall renew the number or numbers as often as they are obliterated or defaced, and if any occupier fails to mark such receptacle with its number or numbers, or to renew the number or numbers thereon as aforesaid within one week after notice from the Council the Shire Secretary or other officer of the Council authorised in that behalf, such occupier shall be guilty of an offence against the By-Law.
- 16. The occupier shall on the day the Council allots as that day on which refuse shall be collected from his premises place the receptacle in a position close to the property line or in a similar position suitable for the collection of such receptacle from the premises upon which such premises front, adjoin or abut, or on the naturestrip or footpath in the front of such premises or in such other position as directed by the Council.
- 17. A person shall not place or permit to allow to be placed or remain in or upon any street road lane or right of way any receptacle except upon the day or the evening preceding the day designated for the collection of refuse for the premises to which the receptacle shall belong.

- 18. A person shall not deposit or leave any refuse on any street road lane passage or right of way otherwise than in a receptacle as upon the days herein referred to in Clause 16 hereof.
- 19. For the purpose of this By-Law any notice or order required to be given may be signed by the Shire Secretary Health Surveyor or other officer of the Council authorised in that behalf acting on behalf of the Council.
- 20. Any person doing any act forbidden to be done or failing to do any act directed to be done by this By-Law shall be guilty of an offence against this By-Law and shall be liable to a penalty of not more than four penalty units and in the case of a continuing offence a further daily penalty of not more than one penalty unit.

#### "Schedule"

Those parts of the municipal district of the Shire of Waranga, which, under the provisions of the Shire of Waranga Planning Scheme or under the provisions of any interim development order relating to such Planning Scheme, are included in a Township Zone.






