hereby so exempt the said works pursuant to Ss. 6 (4), subject to the conditions shown below.

- The structures shall be removed and the area reinstated to the satisfaction of the committee of management before 1 May 1987 unless an extension of time is applied for and approved by the Minister prior to that date.
- Storage bins shall be cleared regularly or as necessary to prevent overtopping to the satisfaction of the committee of management.
- The storage area and its immediate surrounds shall be maintained clear of litter and the structure shall be kept in good repair to the satisfaction of the committee of management.
- Recycling centres shall be established only with the prior agreement to the relevant committee of management.
- Recycling centres shall not have a plan area greater than 3M × 2M or a height greater than 2M
- All recycling centres must be sited such that no vegetation is required to be removed or trimmed.
- In the event of damage by vandalism or accident the structure shall be repaired or removed and the area reinstated to the satisfaction of the committee of management.
