5. Recycling centres shall not have a plan area greater than 3M x 2M or a height greater than 2M.
6. All recycling centres must be sited such that no vegetation is required to be removed or trimmed.
7. In the event of damage by vandalism or accident the structure shall be repaired or removed and the area reinstated to the satisfaction of the committee of management.
