AMALGAMATION OF THE ROYAL MELBOURNE HOSPITAL AND ESSENDON AND DISTRICT MEMORIAL HOSPITAL

Whereas pursuant to section 25 (b) of the *Hospitals and Charities Act 1958* and in accordance with sections 27 and 28 of the said Act the Department of Health has recommended to the Minister for Health that the incorporated subsidised institutions known as The Royal Melbourne Hospital and Essendon and District Memorial Hospital be amalgamated;

And whereas pursuant to section 29 of the said Act the Governor in Council may determine that in accordance with such recommendation any two or more subsidised institutions shall be amalgamated;

Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof doth by this Order:

- (a) determine in accordance with the aforesaid recommendation that the incorporated subsidised institutions known as The Royal Melbourne Hospital and Essendon and District Memorial Hospital shall be amalgamated;
- (b) specify, for the purposes of section 30 (1) of the said Act, that the date on and from which the consequences of amalgamation of The Royal Melbourne Hospital and Essendon and District Memorial Hospital shall follow is 18 March 1986;
- (c) specify that the name of the new corporation formed by the amalgamation of The Royal Melbourne Hospital and Essendon and District Memorial Hospital is The Amalgamated Melbourne and Essendon Hospitals; and

- (d) approve cancellation of the registration of The Royal Melbourne Hospital and Essendon and District Memorial Hospital pursuant to the said Act.

And the Honourable David Ronald White, Her Majesty's Minister for Health for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.

HOSPITALS AND CHARITIES ACT 1958 Section 63A

Whereas, pursuant to sub-section (1) of section 63A of the *Hospitals and Charities Act 1958*, the Governor in Council may, by Order published in the *Government Gazette*, add the name of a subsidised incorporated institution to, or delete the name of an institution from Table A or Table B in the Fifth Schedule to the said Act;

And whereas as from and including the 18 March 1986 the subsidised incorporated institutions known as The Royal Melbourne Hospital and Essendon and District Memorial Hospital were amalgamated and, as a consequence, a subsidised incorporated institution known as The Amalgamated Melbourne and Essendon Hospitals was created and pursuant to sub-section (1) of section 30 of the said Act is deemed to be the successor of the subsidised incorporated institutions so amalgamated;

Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof does by this Order (a) delete from Table A of the Fifth Schedule to the *Hospitals and Charities Act 1958* the names The Royal Melbourne Hospital and Essendon and District Memorial Hospital; and (b) add to the said Table A of the Fifth Schedule to the said Act the

name of the subsidised incorporated institution known as The Amalgamated Melbourne and Essendon Hospitals.

And the Honourable David Ronald White, Her Majesty's Minister for Health for the State of

Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
