CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT FOR PROVISIONS 1986-87

1. For the purposes of these contracts the word "Government" shall mean the Government of the State of Victoria; and the word "Treasurer" shall mean the Treasurer of the said State.
2. All the articles are to be of the best quality of the several kinds in the best conditions, and in conformity with the Health Acts, and to be delivered in sound packages, free from all charges for cartage, freight, &c. The goods shall be delivered as may be directed by the officer ordering the supply.
3. As the exact quantity of any article which may be required cannot be stated, the estimate being approximate only, the Government will not be bound by the quantity stated in the Schedule, but will be at liberty to order more or less, according to circumstances, and the contractor will be bound to supply the same as ordered.
4. The Government reserves the right to purchase otherwise than from the contractor any of the articles specified in the Schedule in the event of an emergency.
5. Supplies for country districts for which no local contract may have been taken, or for which the contract has been terminated, may be ordered under the Melbourne and Metropolitan contract.
6. The Melbourne and Metropolitan District will include the Sunbury Training Centre and places within a radius of 32 km from the Elizabeth-street Post Office. Delivery must be made at the places, institutions, &c., named in the Schedules, or as directed by the officer ordering the supply.
7. Except where otherwise stated in the schedule, the value of all packages, cases, casks &c, whether bulk be broken or not, must be included in the prices stated in the contractor's tender; all such packages, &c., shall be considered the property of the Government, and no charges or expenses whatsoever beyond the price tendered and set out in the schedule will be allowed to the contractor for any articles or packages, cases, casks &c. The net weight or quantity only will be paid for. The contractor must provide, without extra charge, whatever labour may be required in the packing of stores. Butter boxes and soap boxes (not including fancy soaps), jam jars, flour, meal, and potato bags will remain the property of the contractor, the empty containers to be removed from the place of delivery at the contractor's expense.
8. Meat supplied under these conditions must be slaughtered and supplied in accordance with the provisions of the Health Act and Regulations. Any infringement of this condition will subject the contractor, on report from the Tender Board to such mulct, not exceeding One hundred dollars, as the Treasury may direct, and the amount will be deducted from the contractor's account, or from the security money.
9. The supplies coming under the head of Rations and Medical Comforts are to be delivered direct to the establishment entitled thereto on the written order of the officer in charge. All other supplies will be ordered by the head of the Department concerned or any officer authorized by him, and shall be delivered as may be directed by the officer ordering the supply.
10. At the time of delivering supplies, the contractor shall produce the order for the same to the officer authorized to accept delivery, and such officer shall acknowledge thereon the receipt of the stores accepted, and shall return the order to the contractor, who shall render his account as soon as possible after the delivery of the supplies, accompanied by the receipted delivery order. The rates or quantities quoted in the orders cannot be exceeded.
11. Where the railway facilities are available, the contractor shall, except where delivery is required direct into institutions, use the Railways for the transport of goods. When the contractor is required to make delivery of goods at a railway station for transmission by rail for any Department excepting Departments of the Commonwealth he shall obtain a receipt for the goods on a Victorian Railways consignment note as an authority for the Railways to act as agent for, and charge the freight to, the Department as shall be named therein. In all instances the contractor shall consign goods at Railways' Risk and state the order number and description of goods on the consignment note. Should the goods thus forwarded be rejected the contractor must bear the cost of replacing such goods for which service the Department must not be charged any additional freight costs. Any infringement of this condition will subject the contractor to such mulct, as is provided in clause 20. In the event of loss through failure on part of the contractor to comply with this condition the contractor will be held responsible and the amount of the loss incurred thereby will be deducted as provided in clause 12.
12. Orders must receive prompt execution; in the event of the goods not being delivered at the time mentioned in the order or within such other time as the officer ordering the supply may specify for delivery, it will be competent for such officer, or the head of the Department to whom the goods are to be supplied, on giving the contractor twenty-four hour's notice, to purchase the supplies, or any like supplies that are suitable for the service, at the contractor's risk, and the extra expense incurred over and above the contract price (if any) will be deducted from the contractor's account or from the security money.
13. The acceptance of the supplies shall be subject to the approval of the officer authorized to take delivery of the stores, or such officer as shall be named in the conditions.

14. If the officer in charge of stores be not satisfied as to the quantity or quality of the stores, or if, after taking delivery of any stores or material, he shall discover any deficiency or defect therein, he may return such deficient or defective stores or material to the contractor, and shall report the same to the head of his department and to the Tender Board.

15. In the event of a difference of opinion between the contractor and the officer receiving the supplies as to the quality the same is to be decided, in cases where the article is not of a perishable nature, by a Board of Survey composed of persons named by the Treasurer of the State for the time being; and the decision of the Board is to be considered final. In the event of the decision being against the contractor, the survey fees and expenses (if any) will be deducted as in clause 12.

16. In cases where the article is of a perishable nature, or when from some other cause injury would be sustained either by the person to whom the rations or stores are due or by the contractor in waiting for a Board to survey, the head of the Department or officer authorized to take delivery will have power to reject such article or articles as are obviously of inferior quality, it being understood that he will be responsible to the Government for so doing, and that the contractor must take back the rejected article and supply good in its stead; failing which it, or any like supply suitable for the Service, will be obtained by the officer requiring it as in clause 12. In case of the rejection or return of any supplies, the contractor shall bear the whole cost of replacing the supplies so rejected or returned.

17. If the Board shall decide that the article is not proper quality it must immediately be replaced by the contractor; failing which it, or any like supply suitable for the Service, will be procured by the officer requiring it, and the expense charged as in clause 12.

18. In the case of supplies for Mental Hospitals it will be competent for a Board of Survey, consisting of the medical superintendent (or, in his absence, of the medical officer) and any two officers named by him, to examine and reject any supplies that may be objected to. It must be distinctly understood, however, that the contractor will have a right of appeal to the Treasurer of the State for the time being, such appeal to be made in writing within 24 hours of the rejection; but, pending such appeal, he must at once supply others of approved quality; failing which, the supplies required; or any like supplies suitable for the Service, may be obtained by the officer concerned, and the expense charged as in clause 12.

19. In the case of supplies for Mental Institutions, it will also be competent for two or more of the official visitors, in conjunction with the medical

superintendent, to reject supplies that they may consider not in accordance with contract; and in such cases the reference to a Board of Survey will not be deemed to be necessary.

20. A refusal to execute orders, irregularity in the quantity or quality of the supplies, or delay in delivering or replacing them when required, will subject the contractor, upon report from the Tender Board, to such mulct, not exceeding One hundred dollars, as the said Treasury may direct and the amount may be deducted as in clause 12. It will also be in the power of the said Treasurer, upon such refusal, irregularity or delay, to terminate the contract forthwith, and forfeit the whole or any part of the security money, and, in addition, the contractor will be disqualified from tendering or holding any future contract or contracts for a period of not less than twelve months from the date of such disqualification.

21. Contractors are not at liberty to transfer their contracts under cover of power of attorney, coupled with an interest or otherwise, and no such transfer will be recognized by the Government. *If it is found during the currency of the contract that the contractor has not conformed to the condition of the advertisement—which stipulates that if a tenderer be a member of a firm and such firm be interested in the contract, the tender shall be in the name of the firm and not in that of the individual—then the Treasurer may, on the recommendation of the Tender Board, determine the contract, and forfeit the security money.*

22. It will be competent for the Tender Board to terminate the contract, without notice, should there be reason to know that the contractor takes advantage of his contract to communicate with a prisoner.

23. The contract entered into under these conditions is not to be considered as being broken, infringed, or vitiated by the importation of stores for the Government service, or by any contracts or purchases made by the Agent General for Victoria; or by the consumption of the produce or surplus stock of any Government establishment, or by any article being made at and supplied for the use of any Government establishment.

24. Notwithstanding anything contained to the contrary in section 152 of the Customs Act 1901-71, it is hereby expressly provided that upon any alteration of the duty collected affecting the goods included in this contract, the contract price shall not be altered, and the contract may be terminated at the option of either party by two months' notice in writing from the first day of the calendar month next ensuing and within the period for which the contract is made. The contract for the unaffected items shall remain in full force and effect. Any notice to be served under this condition shall be deemed to have been duly served if sent to the

contractor in a registered letter to his last known place of business or abode.

25. Under no circumstances other than those mentioned in clause 24 will a contractor be permitted to abandon his contract. In the event of the contractor failing to carry on the contract, the contract security money will in that case be absolutely forfeited and, in addition, the contractor will be held liable for any loss which the Government may sustain in consequence of such failure.

26. Every person engaged in the service tendered for in the schedule shall be paid such wages and employed subject to such labour conditions as are or may be determined by any Australian Conciliation and Arbitration Commission Award or any State Conciliation and Arbitration Court Award determination.

27. The contractor will be held liable for any damage to Government property occasioned by the contractor or any person engaged by the contractor during the performance of any service required under the contract.

STIPULATIONS FOR SUPPLIES OF PROVISIONS AND GROCERIES

SUPPLIES GENERALLY

Supplies of items for Districts for which no local contracts have been taken may be ordered under the Melbourne District contract, for delivery f.o.r., Melbourne.

Supplies made under the contract shall be of the best quality or grade of the brand available.

For all supplies particular attention is drawn to Clause 2 of the Conditions of Contract as to quality.

Adjustment of Contract Rates for Flour and Bread

If before, or during the contract period the price of flour is increased or decreased, the prices to be paid under the contract may be increased or decreased by application to the Tender Board in accordance with the undermentioned formula—

For deliveries of Flour made after such variation comes into operation:

Jute Bags—67 kg.—at the rate of 13·4 cents per bag for every \$2 of increase or decrease in the price per tonne.

Calico Bags—25 kg.—at the rate of 5 cents per bag for every \$2 of increase or decrease in the price per tonne.

For deliveries of Bread made not less than 24 hours after such variation comes into operation—at the rate of 0·176 cents per kg. for every \$2 of increase or decrease in the price per tonne of flour.

Bread may be baked at any Government Establishment without infringing this contract.

Deliveries to institutions must be of bread baked on the same day. Deliveries are required at institutions before 8.30 a.m. Where a Public Holiday falls on a Friday or a Monday deliveries are required on Saturday of bread baked on the Saturday.

Butter

All butter must be supplied in cartons as originally packed. The cartons must bear the number of the establishment where the butter is packaged, the net weight and the grade.

All butter supplied shall comply with the following specifications:

Moisture*	not more than 16%
Salt*	not more than 3%
pH cultured butter*	less than pH 7
Standard plate count	not more than 10 000 per g
Coliforms	less than 10 per g
Yeast	less than 10 per g
Mould	less than 10 per g
Psychrotroph	less than 100 per g

Note *indicates a requirement under the Food and Drug Regulations.

Cheese

The cheese must be first-class quality, semi or fully matured, as ordered, and not less than three months old. If the quantity admits, it shall be placed in cartons for transport.

Cereals

As a guarantee of quality, Rice, when ordered in quantities of 25 kg. and over, must be supplied in original bags as delivered by the miller or dresser. Such bags must be branded "Rice, Dressed", and shall also have stencilled thereon the miller or dresser's name and the distinguishing mark indicative of the quality or grade. The bags thus stencilled shall contain Rice milled and dressed by the miller or dresser whose name appears thereon. Supplies not in conformity with the foregoing condition will be rejected.

Oatmeal must be supplied in original bags as delivered by millers.

Fruit and Vegetables

All fruit and vegetables delivered shall be packed, graded and marked in accordance with the provisions of the "Fruit and Vegetable Packing Regulations 1964", and shall be subject to the provisions set out in the "Specifications for Supply and Delivery of Fruit and Vegetables", copies of which may be obtained from the Tender Board Offices.

The weight stamped on the tins in accordance with the regulations under the Commerce Act, as indicated the minimum net quantity that each tin contains, shall for the purpose of this contract be taken as the actual contents when computing the quantity supplied.

Jams

When Jam is supplied in jars the jars remain the property of the contractor, and must be removed by the contractor at his own expense when empty.

Milk

The milk must be fresh, pure, and the best quality, and subject to test when required by the Department, and supplied at such times as the Department may require. Should the contractor fail to supply at the time specified in the order or at such times as may be indicated in any general notice to the contractor his contract may be cancelled forthwith and his security, if any, forfeited, or should the supply prove to be not of contract quality it will be rejected and any expense incurred will be charged to the contractor.

Potatoes and Onions

Supplies of potatoes are to be of "No. 1 Grade" in accordance with Regulation 25 of the Fruit and Vegetables Packing Regulations 1964 as amended and shall consist of sound potatoes of similar varietal characteristics and having a skin which is not immature; shall be free from damage caused by the ordinary process of peeling, and shall be reasonably free from second growth, sprouting, greening from exposure, deterioration caused during storage or by any abnormal condition of growth, and each potato shall weigh no less than 80 grams and no more than 450 grams.

However, during the period 1st November to 1st March new Grade potatoes may be supplied in lieu of No. 1 Grade with the consent of the Officer ordering the supply.

Bags to remain the property of the contractor. Weight of bags to be deducted.

If the price of potatoes becomes abnormally high, the heads of the various departments concerned may, if they think fit, cause rice or any other suitable food to be occasionally substituted in lieu thereof.

PRICES

Contract rates listed are subject to "rise and fall" and all authorized variations will be gazetted.

AVAILABILITY OF SUPPLIES

Owing to existing difficulties in obtaining supplies of various items, the penal provisions of Clause 12 of the Conditions of Contract are not to be enforced without reference to the Tender Board.

MINIMUM ORDERS

Schedule No. 2/01.—Provisions—

Items contained in this schedule represent commodities for which minimum order "one drop" deliveries have been stipulated against each item.

The figure which has been stipulated against each item, or group of similar type items, represents the minimum amount which may be ordered.

Institutions which are unable to comply with the minimum order as stated will purchase from Schedule No. 2/02—Groceries.

Schedule No. 2/02—Groceries—

Schedule No. 2/02 has been formed to cater for the requirements of those institutions which cannot comply with the minimum orders as stated in Schedule No. 2/01.

This schedule has been let as a whole to one supplier.

General—

The prices gazetted cover delivery of goods to institutions within the Melbourne and Metropolitan District.

Goods supplied under these schedules will generally be for Melbourne and Metropolitan based institutions including Sunbury. However, country based institutions may purchase under these schedules where no local contracts have been taken and in these instances goods will be delivered free on rail at Melbourne for transmission on consignment note, freight to be debited to the respective Departmental Railways Credit Account.
