Police Regulation (Amendment) Act 1985 DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of the Parliament of Victoria passed in the thirty-fourth year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia entitled the *Police Regulation* (Amendment) Act 1985, it is enacted that the Act comes into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.

Now therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby fix Tuesday, 11 February 1986 as the day on which sections 11 and 12 of the Police Regulation (Amendment) Act 1985, shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria, at Melbourne, this eleventh day of February in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eightysix and in the thirty-fifth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
