RETIREMENT VILLAGES (FEES FOR EXEMPTIONS) REGULATIONS

It is proposed to make Regulations entitled the "Retirement Villages (Fees for Exemptions) Regulations 1987" establishing the fees payable by applicants seeking an exemption from the provisions of the Retirement Village Bill 1986. The objectives of the Statutory Rule are to prescribe fees for the applications made pursuant to section 6 of the Bill and to ensure that in relation to one class of applicants, the fee levels prescribed reflect the estimated average costs of processing such applications and in relation to Religious and Charitable Organisations, that the fee levels are reduced to a point which strikes an appropriate balance between the aforementioned objective and recognition of the special position of these organisations.

The Statement concludes that because of the requirements of the Legislation, fees may only be charged pursuant to Regulations. It also concludes that applicants under Clause 6 (2) of the Bill should be charged a fee which reflects the user pays principle and that Religious or Charitable applicants under section 6 (1) of the Bill should be charged a fee of approximately half of that amount in recognition of their special position.

Post-Secondary Education Act 1978 COUNCIL OF WARRNAMBOOL COLLEGE OF TECHNICAL AND FURTHER

EDUCATION—CHANGE OF NAME AND AMENDMENTS TO CONSTITUTION

Under section 23 (4) of the *Post-Secondary Education Act* 1978 on the recommendation of the Victorian Post-Secondary Education Commission, made at the written request of a Council, the Governor in Council by this Order makes the following amendments to the Constitution of the Warrnambool College of Technical and Further Education published in the *Government Gazette* on 4 July 1984.

- 1. The name of the Council is changed to the "Council of South West College of Technical and Further Education".
 - 2. In Clause 2-
 - (a) after definition of "Act" insert:

"Campus" means a geographically distinct site of operation of the College so designated by the Council.

- (b) in the definitions of "College" and "Council" for "Warrnambool" substitute "South West".
- (c) after the definition of "general staff" insert "Head of Campus" means that person who is responsible to the Director of the College for the general operation and management of a Campus of the College'.
- 3. In Clause 3 for "Warrnambool" substitute 'South West".
- 4. In Clause 4-
- (a) in sub-clause (1) for "eighteen" substitute "twenty".
- (b) for sub-clause (1) (a) substitute:
 - (a) "Eight (8) members appointed by the Governor in Council of whom:

Four (4) must be members having a special interest in Technical and Further Education or an association with those fields of industry and commerce relating to the educational programs of the College.

One (1) must be a member having a special interest in Technical and Further Education and must be a resident of either the City or Borough of Port Fairy,

Shire of Belfast, Shire of Mortlake or Shire of Minhamite.

One (1) must be a member having a special interest in Technical and Further Education and must be a resident of either the Shire of Heytesbury, Shire of Hampden, Shire of Mortlake or Town of Camperdown.

One (1) must be a member having a special interest in Technical and Further Education and must be a resident of either the City of Portland or Shire of Portland.

One (1) must be a member having a special interest in Technical and Further Education and must be a resident of either the City of Hamilton, Shire of Dundas, Shire of Glenelg, Shire of Mt Rouse or Shire of Wannon.

No member of the staff or any student of the College is eligible to be a member under this paragraph (a)."

- (c) for sub-clause (1) (f) substitute—
 - "(f) Three (3) must be members of the teaching staff elected by the teaching staff in a manner prescribed to achieve broad representation from teaching staff located at the various Campuses of the College."
- (d) in sub-clause (1) (d) "Principal" substitute "Director".
- (e) for sub-clause (1) (e) substitute—
 - "(e) One (1) must be a Head of Campus elected by the Heads of Campus of the College."
- (f) for sub-clause (1) (i) substitute-
 - "(i) Three (3) must be appointed by cooption by the Council from the community as persons having a special interest in Technical and Further Education and its relationship with commerce, industry, the professions or other community interests but no member of the staff or any student of the College is eligible to be a member under this paragraph (i)."
- (g) for sub-clause (2) substitute:
 - 'A member of Council elected pursuant to paragraphs (e), (f) and (g) of sub-clause 4 (1) is hereinafter called an "elected member".'
- (h) for sub-clauses (4) (a) (b) and (c) substitute-
 - "(4) (a) Members of the Council (other than the Director, student member and Head of Campus member) hold office for a period of three (3) years from the date of such members' appointment or election except as provided under paragraph (c) of sub-clause 4 (10).

- "(b) A student member of the Council and Head of Campus member of the Council hold office for one (1) year from the date of their respective appointment or election except as provided under paragraph (c) of sub-clause 4 (10)."
- (i) in sub-clause (6) for "Principal or Deputy Principal" substitute "Director".
- (j) in sub-clause (14) delete "Acting Principal" and "Acting Deputy Principal" and substitute "Director".
- (k) in sub-clause 10 (a) after "or if any casual vacancy occurs in the office of an elected member" insert "or student member appointed under paragraph (h) or sub-clause 4 (1)"
- 5. In clause 5-
- (a) in sub-clause (2) for "Principal" substitute "Director" and delete "Deputy Principal".
- (b) in sub-clause (3) for "Principal" substitute "Director" and delete "Deputy Principal".
- (c) in sub-clause (8) for "Principal" substitute "Director".
- 6. In clause 6-
- (a) for sub-clause (3) substitute:
 - "(3) (a) Hold examinations and make assessments wherever it deems necessary or desirable in the several subjects and educational programs offered by the College;
 - "(b) Issue appropriately entitled documentary evidence in relation to examinations and assessments:
 - "(c) Confer diplomas and associate diplomas for successful completion of courses of study approved by the Commission and accredited by the TAFE Accreditation Board or such other body as is charged with the responsibility for accreditation of TAFE courses of Study."
- (b) in sub-clause 11 for "Principal' substitute "Director".
- (c) in sub-clause 32 for "Principal" substitute "Director".
- 7. For Clause 9 substitute-
 - "9. The Council may use land, buildings and equipment vested in or under the control of the Minister for Education which when this Order takes effect constitute or are contained in the premises of the College, and any building or equipment subsequently erected or placed on or in the said land or buildings, and from time to time any other land, buildings and equipment vested in or under the management and control of the Minister which the Minister

agrees in writing may be used by the Council either solely for the purpose of the College or jointly with another institution".

- 8. In clause 10-
- (a) in sub-clause (1) for "Principal" substitute "Director";
- (b) in sub-clause (3) for "\$10 000" substitute "\$50 000":
- (c) after sub-clause (7) insert:
