Survey Coordination Act 1958 ADOPTION OF SURVEY MARK AS PERMANENT MARK

Pursuant to the power conferred under section 15 of the above Act, I hereby adopt as a permanent mark any mark consisting of a metallic bar, rod or pipe driven or placed in the ground to a depth of not less than two metres and which has a concrete or metal cover placed over it which bears the words "Survey Mark" embossed or raised on its upper surface. This mark is to be described as Type 10 Permanent Mark or Rod Type Permanent Mark.

RETIREMENT VILLAGES REGULATIONS 1987

It is proposed to make regulations entitled the "Retirement Villages Regulations 1987". The regulations prescribe various matters for the purposes of the Retirement Villages Act 1986.

The objectives of the Statutory Rule are:

- (i) to prescribe a formula for the calculation of the adjusted maintenance charge for the purposes of section 38 of the Retirement Villages Act 1986, and which arrives at an appropriate balance between:
 - (a) the need of the owner or manager to recoup the cost of providing the services;
 - (b) the limited financial capacity of resident (whose only source of income may be the age pension).
- (ii) prescribe a document for the purposes of section 19 of the Act.

The Regulatory Impact Statement concludes that the adoption of a consumer price index based formula is considered the most satisfactory and cost efficient means of providing a mechanism for adjusting the levies raised on residents to recoup the costs and expenses of providing the goods and services to them by the owner or manager of a village. The statement also concludes that the prescription of the option agreement for the purposes of section 19 of the Act enables the policy behind that section to be fully implemented.


