



Temporary Transfer of Water Rights (Irrigation Districts) and Temporary Transfer of Sales Water

The Rural Water Commission under the provisions of the Water Act hereby makes the following by-law:

#### Part 1-Interpretation

**Definitions** 

"Common Ownership" means land shown as being in identical ownership in a Register of Lands prepared pursuant to section 63 of the Water Act.

"Former policies" means the temporary transfer of sales and the temporary amalgamation of holdings which the Commission has allowed in the past.

"Landholder" means an owner or occupier as shown in the Register of Lands.

"Other party" includes a mortgagee, caveator, unpaid vendor, annuitant, lessees, sharefarmer or any other person having an interest in or holding a charge or lien on any land comprised in any holding from which water is to be transferred.

"Holding" means the lands comprised in any single entry in the appropriate register of lands in force at the relevant time.

"Sales Water" means water made available under section 65F (2) or under section 86 of the Water Act.

#### Part II-Transfers of Water Right

- 1. Save as otherwise provided this part and the schedules shall have effect within the Goulburn-Murray, Macalister and Campaspe Irrigation Districts.
- 2. Applications for the approval to negotiate a transfer of water right to a holding must be made in or to the effect of the form contained in the First Schedule.
- 3. Each application for approval to negotiate a transfer of water right shall be accompanied by a fee in accordance with the following criteria:
  - (a) transfers between separate holdings—\$60
  - (b) transfers between holdings in common ownership—\$30
  - (c) transfers by landholders who have previously transferred water under the Commission's former policies and whose circumstances are the same in every particular—\$30.
- 4. Approval to negotiate the transfer of water right to a holding will be deemed to be granted by the signature on the form referred to in the First Schedule by the officer authorised by the Commission and such approval shall remain valid for the period specified by that officer.
- 5. Notice of agreement to transfer water right must be made in or to the effect of the form contained in the Second Schedule.
- 6. A notice of agreement to transfer shall not be valid unless the transferee has first obtained the consent of the Commission in the manner prescribed in clause 4.

- 7. Where the transferee is not the owner of the holding to which water is to be transferred, the transferred shall obtain the consent of such owner to a transfer.
- 8. The transferor shall obtain and lodge with the Commission the consent of any other party.

#### Part III—Limitations on Transfer of Water Right

- 9. This part shall apply and have effect within the Goulburn-Murray, Macalister and Campaspe Irrigation Districts.
- 10. Not more than 70% of the total water right allocated to any one holding may be transferred in any one irrigation season.
- 11. In its consideration of any application for the approval to negotiate a transfer of water right the Commission shall have regard to security of existing water supplies, channel capacity, drainage implications and salinity criteria in so far as the same are relevant to the holding to which water right is proposed to be transferred.

#### Part IV-Transfer of Sales Water

- 12. This part and the schedules shall apply to sales water supplied from the works of the Goulburn-Murray, Macalister and Campaspe Irrigation Districts.
- 13. The provisions of clauses 2 to 7 inclusive shall apply to this part as if the words "water right" read "sales water".
- 14. The transferor shall obtain and lodge with the Commission the consent of any sharefarmer or lessee having an interest in the land from which the sales water is to be transferred.

Part V—Limitations on Transfer of Sales Water
15. This part applies to the transfer of sales water supplied from the works of the Goulburn-Murray, Macalister and Campaspe Irrigation

16. In its consideration of any application for the approval to negotiate a transfer of sales water the Commission shall have regard to security of existing water supplies, channel capacity, drainage implications and salinity criteria in so far as the same are relevant to the holding to which sales water is proposed to be transferred.

The foregoing By-law was made by the Rural Water Commission of Victoria on 18 June 1987 and the Seal of the Commission was hereunto affixed by the Authority of the Board.

Aboriginal Adoption—The purposes of the regulation are to protect the wishes of a relinquishing parent concerning placement in the Aboriginal community, to give an Aboriginal Agency a clear role in managing and determining access, and to ensure that contact occurs between an Aboriginal child and the Aboriginal community.

Requirements for Parent extending period for withdrawing consent—The purposes of the regulation are to ensure that an Adoption Agency is notified if a parent has extended the period for withdrawing consent to adoption, to avoid legal uncertainty (in such cases) as to the end of the period for withdrawing consent, and to allow early placement of the child.

Incorporation of Adoption Information Service Regulations—These regulations do not alter the intent of the former regulations. The purpose of the regulations is to enable administration of some of the Adoption Information Service provisions of the Act and to authorise the Director-General to charge a fee (\$20) for Adoption Information Service applications to the Department.

Summary—In each case cost-benefit analysis of several ways of achieving the purposes was undertaken, concluding that net benefit rested with making the regulations in the form proposed, Further details are contained in the Regulatory Impact Statement.
