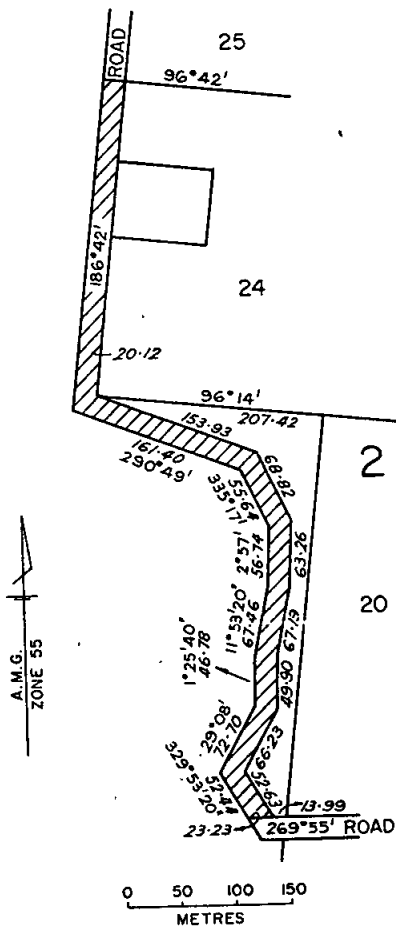

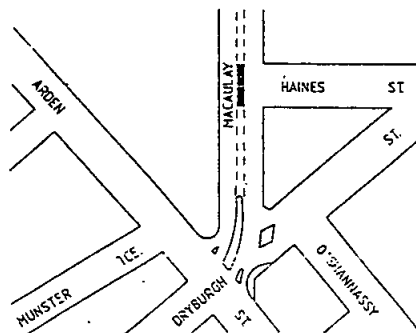

**Short Title**

This By-law is the Victoria Building Regulations By-law.

**Repeal of By-law No. 31**

By-law No. 31 of the Shire of Mount Rouse is hereby expressly repealed.

**Commencement of By-law and Area of**

**Operation**

This By-law shall come into operation on the day after the day of publication thereof or of notice of the making thereof in the *Victoria Government Gazette* and shall apply throughout the Municipal District of the Shire of Mount Rouse.

**Regulations**

- (a) The minimum area depth and width of frontage specified in column 4 of the table 11-6 of the Victoria Building Regulations (hereinafter called "The Regulations") are hereby adopted as the minimum area depth and width and width of frontage of the allotment on which a building of Class I, II or X occupancy as described in Regulations shall be constructed.
- (b) The minimum distance of the external walls of any building of Class I, II or X occupancy as described in the Regulations from the frontage of any allotment shall be 4-5 metres.
- (c) Except as is otherwise provided in the Regulations, the minimum distance of external walls of any buildings of Class I, II or X occupancy as described in the Regulations from the boundaries other than frontage of any allotment shall be as specified in column 4 of table 11-6 of the Regulations.
- (d) Exempting Buildings and Structures classified as Class Xb or Xc under the Victoria Building Regulations and which are constructed on farm land and are used for farming purposes from the provision of the Regulations.

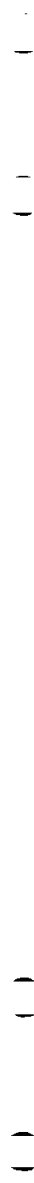

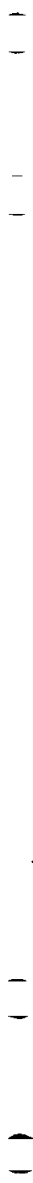
