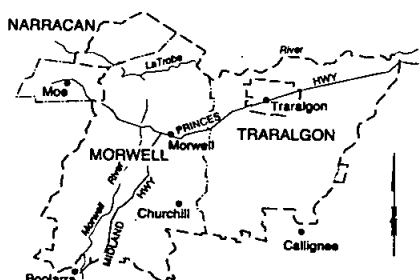

By-law No. 74

In pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Local Government Act 1958*, and of any and every power it thereto enabling the Mayor, Councillors and Burgesses of the Borough of Wonthaggi order as follows:

1. By-laws Nos. 16, 30, 45 and 46 are hereby repealed.

2. In this By-law:—

"Public Places" shall have the same meaning as in section 3 of the *Summary Offences Act 1966*;

"Goods" means all goods whatsoever within the meaning of section 3 of the *Goods Act 1958*;

"Council" means the municipal council of the Borough of Wonthaggi;

"Footway" means and includes every footpath, land, thoroughfare or clear public place within the Borough of Wonthaggi habitually used by pedestrian rather than vehicular traffic;

"Street" or "Road" means any thoroughfare used or reserved for vehicular traffic;

3. No street hawker or itinerant trader dealing in goods shall sell or offer for sale any goods in or upon any of the streets, roads, footways or public places within the municipality of the Borough of Wonthaggi on any day at any time without the written consent of the Council in the form of a letter or permit and having paid a fee of not less than

\$100.00 nor more than \$200.00 per month, to be set by Council after considering all circumstances of each application and nature of the business concerned, all fees to be paid annually in advance. These fees may be set annually by Council without the necessity of By-law Amendments.

4. Stands in streets, roads and public places shall be appointed in such positions and in such numbers as the Council may from time to time determine, and no trading may take place whilst travelling to or from the appointed position.

5. The following rules shall be observed by all persons holding the right to use appointed stands:

- (a) At all times keep the stand and area near the stand clean and free from litter as defined by the *Litter Act* 1964;
- (b) Not at any time to cause or permit or suffer any nuisance to exist on or contiguous to his vehicle;
- (c) Not place any box, basket, or receptacle or other thing (except his vehicle) upon the stand or on the roadway or footpath contiguous to his stand;

- (e) Produce his/her Licence to the Health Surveyor or any Police or Council Officer when requested;
- (f) Have his/her name painted in a conspicuous place on the right or off side of his/her vehicle in Roman Letters of not less than 40mm in the shortest diameter of the same either in white on black ground or in black on a white ground, and at all places keep such letters legible;
- (g) Not sell at any place other than at the stand he/she is licensed to occupy.

6. No cart, truck, barrow, or other vehicle shall be used on any appointed stand unless the same shall:

- (a) have been previously approved by the Borough Health Surveyor and shall not exceed 5 metres in length.

7. That the Council may at any time revoke the authority to use any appointed stand if the holder:

- (a) (i) Commits any offence against the By-Law;
- (ii) Is convicted for assault, drunkenness, obscene language, brawling or riotous behaviour, or such like offence;
- (iii) Is not cleanly in habits and appearance;
- (iv) Is convicted of any offence under Health, Pure Food, Fish and Game, Fruit, or Weights and Measures Acts;
- (v) Who acts in any discreditable manner in the conduct of his stand;

(b) When a licence is revoked under the section, notice in writing under the hand of the Town Clerk of such revocation shall be served on the Licensee, whose right to occupy such stand shall then cease, and any monies paid in advance may be declared forfeited by the Council.

8. The Council may from time to time:

- (a) abolish, enlarge, or diminish any stand;
- (b) move any stand in any direction in its vicinity.

9. If any stand is abolished during the currency of the licence therefore the Council may allot to the Licensee thereof a new stand in place thereof, or shall, at the Licensee's option repay him the proportion of the charges paid by him in advance for the abolished stand in full satisfaction of all claims and demands.

10. The Council may at any time appoint any new stand or stands and fix the charges to be paid for the same.

11. (a) When a licence is issued pursuant of this By-law to occupy any stand, the person named in such licence or the permitted transferee, and none other, shall have the right to use or occupy such stand;

(d) The Council may refuse to permit the transfer of a licence to any person not approved of without assigning any reason therefore, and its decision shall be final;

(e) Where a proposed transferee is approved by the Council the licence and transfer duly executed, shall be lodged with the Town Clerk, who shall retain the transfer, and note on the licence the particulars of such transfer. The licence shall be delivered to the transferee, who shall thereupon be the person authorised to occupy such stand;

(f) The fee to be charged for transfer of Licence to be \$5.00 which shall be paid when the licence and the transfer shall be lodged with the Town Clerk as aforesaid.

12. No person other than the licensee of a stand shall sell or assist in selling at such stand unless and until he/she shall have been approved by the Council (whose decision shall be final) and licensed by the Town Clerk. Any licence issued under this Section shall be for one year only, and may be revoked by the Council at any time without assigning any reason

therefore. A Licence under this section shall be in the form of a letter signed by the Town Clerk, but no fees shall be charged for the same. Applicants for a licence under this Section shall sign an application in the form to be supplied by the Town Clerk.

13. The objective of these amendments is to ensure a uniform and co-ordinated approach to accident reporting by:

- (i) providing a different form for the Notice of Accident;
- (ii) standardising the register of injuries with that prescribed under the Accident Compensation Regulations 1985.

The proposed changes do not address what information should be reported to WorkCare Agencies in the event of an accident. This has been the subject of previous extensive consultation.

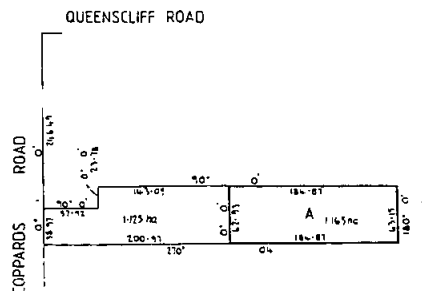

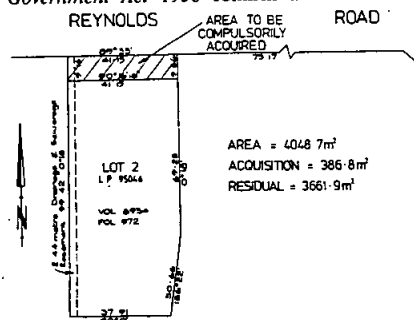

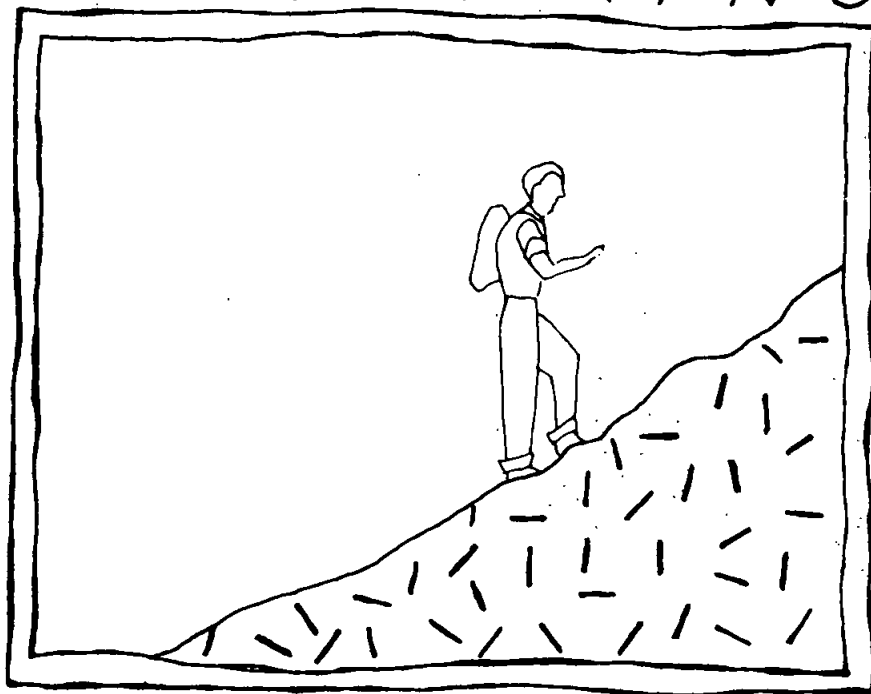
